



## SAMA AUGUST '09 MINI MASTERS

The tournament is open to all SAMA members and SSBT bowlers only.

### DATE AND VENUE

The Tournament shall be held on **30th** of August 2009 Sunday 2 PM. at Orchid Bowl- "The Chevrons", 48 Boon Lay Way #04-01 Singapore 609961

### FORMAT

1. This Mini Masters fun bowl shall be divided into two (2) divisions, namely:
  - a) Men's Division
  - b) Ladies' Division
2. This Mini masters fun bowl shall be composed of 6 games, and, the bowler with the highest total scratch plus handicap after six (6) games shall be declared champion of his or her respective category.
3. All bowlers shall be given a handicap per game. Male max 25, Female 35.
4. There shall be a lane movement every 2 games.

### BOWLER'S HANDICAP

1. Handicap shall be computed using a base average of 180 both for female and male bowlers and with a maximum of 35 and 25 for female and male bowlers respectively.

$$\text{HDPC} = (180 - \text{bowler's Ave}) * 2/3$$

2. 2009 SSBT BOWLERS

All SSBT Bowlers shall be given an entry hdcp based on his/her hdcp on week 16<sup>th</sup> of SSBT 2009 League (a week before July 26 mini masters game).

3. Non-active SSBT Bowlers and New Participants

Non-Active SAMA Bowlers and First time bowlers (new participants –for SAMA members only) shall be given a computed handicap per game which be based on the player's first 6 games.

$$\text{HDPC} = ((180 - (6\text{games total} / 6)) * 2/3$$

4. The bowler's handicap may vary from time to time depending on his/her running average in this MINI-MASTERS. Please refer to the calculations below:

Entry Scratch Pin falls + Current Total Pin falls

Bowler's Average = -----

## REGISTRATION FEE

1. All bowlers shall be required to pay a registration of \$45.00 each which will be utilized to compensate for lane fee, trophies expense, and cash prizes.

<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Runner Up</b>	\$ Cash + trophy
<b>4<sup>th</sup> Runner UP</b>	\$ Cash + trophy
<b>5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> Runner UP</b>	Trophy
<b>High Game</b>	Trophy

Male and Female high game award shall be given to the bowler with highest game played plus handicap, excluding the top 5 male and female winners above.

**NOTE:** Prizes are subject to change should there be *more than or less than 35 bowlers*.

## TIE BREAK

1. The bowler having the lowest difference between the highest and the lowest games shall prevail.
2. In case there is still a tie, the bowler with lowest handicap shall be declared as the winner.
